ABOUT THE FESTIVAL

FANTASY BASEL – The Swiss Comic Con is the largest Swiss festival for pop culture, cosplay and gaming and has been taking place annually over Ascension Holidays (May 14 to 16, 2026) at Messe Basel MCH.

Over three days, the festival covers a wide range of topics on an area of more than 100'000 m². From films and TV series, games, cosplay, comics, anime, manga, art, content creation, medieval market to board games and much more, there's lots to explore.

Over the past twelve years, FANTASY BASEL – The Swiss Comic Con has established itself as the most thematically diverse pop culture event in Europe. In 2025, the festival attracted more than 97'000 visitors. This year's edition is expected to attract over 100'000 attendees.

STARS & ACTORS

From fantasy series to superhero action: only at FANTASY BASEL – The Swiss Comic Con does Superman meet the Night King of the White Walkers. Every year, the festival welcomes stars from current films and series. The list of past guests contains names like Graham McTavish from The Hobbit and The Witcher, Natalia Tena from Game of Thrones, Dan Fogler from Fantastic Beasts and The Walking Dead, Duncan Lacroix from Vikings and Outlander, Cara Buono from Stranger Things or Kevin Sussman from The Big Bang Theory.

Besides various social media stars from platforms like Youtube and Twitch, world-famous illustrators, authors and artists such as John Howe (Lord of the Rings), Ulrich Schröder (Disney), Bernhard Hennen (German fantasy author) or Brian Ian Muir (Star Wars) are among the festival's regular guests.

COSPLAY

The Cosplay Village accommodates over 50 national and international cosplayers and is incomparable in Europe.

Among the highlights are the daily cosplay contests on the main stage. This is where cosplayers present their self-made costumes and props from well-known films and video games in front of a jury of national and international cosplay stars. However, visitors are not required to wear a costume, most come in everyday clothes or their favorite nerd shirt.

SPACE & SCI-FI

Science meets fiction in the sci-fi and space area: every year, the Swiss Space Museum invites visitors on an interactive journey through space. Top-class speakers and scientists are also invited to give exciting talks. In addition, international fan groups present huge fan models and panel discussions from the **STAR WARS** universe and other intergalactic spheres.

Visitors will also meet internationally successful artists from the urban art scene, fantasy illustrators and world-famous comic artists. Over 400 comic and manga artists from Switzerland, Europe and all over the world will be exhibiting in the Artist Alley, and individual motives will be engraved live under the skin in the tattoo art area. Comic stars such as Ralf König, Don Rosa and Enrico Marini have already taken part at the festival, as have Stanley Artgerm Lau, Anna Steinbauer, **NICHTLUSTIG** cartoonist Joscha Sauer and Lord of the Rings illustrator John Howe. Renowned book authors such as Bernhard Hennen and Markus Heitz have also been guests.
