

**Excerpt from the ENVIRONMENTAL CHARTER:
FANTASY BASEL – The Swiss Comic Con**

We are committed to environmentally friendly and sustainable business activities. Partners, exhibitors and sponsors are made aware of our concerns. Exhibitors and dealers are encouraged to act in an environmentally friendly way.

We refrain from cooperating with companies that do not fit in with our environmental policy. With an thought-out waste disposal and recycling concept as well as information for exhibitors we strive for the most environmentally friendly planning of the trade fair appearances.

BOOTH CONSTRUCTION AND FACILITIES:

Since the very beginning we avoid unnecessary infrastructure and decoration. We do not use carpets in the aisles and only very selectively at booths. We use sustainable Rewind carpets wherever possible, a product with the Cradle to Cradle certificate from the Environmental Protection Encouragement Agency EPEA (latex-free and recyclable; production without water and with 83% less gas than conventional carpets).

No carpets are used in the aisles as well as our own booths. We are committed to ensure that infrastructure is as reusable as possible. Therefore, we work with local booth builders and technical suppliers who work with as many reusable elements as possible.

Booth builders are encouraged to use recyclable or biodegradable materials from environmentally friendly and energy-efficient production, which also offer a long service life and reuse options. They should also manage transport efficiently.

There are no parking spaces for employees. All staff (including exhibitors) and volunteers are requested to travel by public transport.

RECYCLING:

Booth constructors and merchants are requested to take back all packaging material and to dispose of it properly afterwards. No packaging materials from stand constructions and furniture may be disposed of at the event.

A recycling station is provided for small materials such as cartons of sales products. All stand owners must bring the waste material to this location themselves.

Carrier bags for customers should be avoided where possible or be made of recyclable material.

ENERGY CONSUMPTION:

Overnight, wherever possible, electrical equipment such as parking lights, computers, etc. are to be turned off. In the event of non-compliance, a surcharge will be levied on the energy flat rates.
